The Prodome / Preictal

Characterized by a change in mood or behavior.

In my case I can be hyper active, overly playful, unfocused, clumsy & show puppy like behavior.

STAGE 2 of a SEIZURE The Aura / Preictal

Signs may include:
Restlessness
Nervousness
Whining / Trembling
Salivating
Excessive affection
Dashing about / pacing
Hiding

STAGE 3 of a **SEIZURE**

The ictal stage is the seizure itself & last from a The Ictal / Seizurefew seconds up to 5 minutes. If longer, seek medical attention immediately. During a seizure the dog may or may not lose consciousness depending the type of seizure.

This stage can last several minutes to several days. Some dogs become lethargic while others will pace frantically. I appear unsteady & disoriented.

Often after a grand mal I am blind for several minutes. My huMom makes sure I have a safe pathway to pace without bumping into furniture or walls. Recovery time varies & it can take weeks before a good dog feels like themselves again.

TONIC-CLONIC

SEIZURE TERMS

SIMPLE PARTIAL - localized to one area on one side of the brain-may spread.

COMPLEX PARTIAL - starts focally within the brain & causes impairment of consciousness.

ABSENSE - aka petit mal begin & end abruptly, lasting a few seconds.

SEIZURE TERMS CONTINUED

TONIC - increase in muscle contraction (stiffening) lasting from seconds to minutes.

CLONIC - involuntary rapid & rhythmic contractions of muscles (jerking).

TONIC-CLONIC - a sequence of tonic phase followed by clonic phase.
